Prison Rape Elimination Act (PREA)

Annual Report 2019-2020

POLICY—Treatment Trends, Inc. (Keenan House) operations seek to lessen suffering caused by addiction to alcohol and other drugs by providing compassionate treatment services in partnership with the criminal justice and human service systems. Our goal is to help individuals gain long term recovery from their addiction and related self-destructive behavior.

Keenan House is a 95 bed all male inpatient non-hospital drug and alcohol rehabilitation facility contracted with single county drug and alcohol commissions, Medicaid managed care and the Pennsylvania Department of corrections.

Consistent with our mission, Keenan House has a “zero tolerance policy” relative to sexual misconduct. The Keenan House program and facility will comply with federal and state law as they pertain to the Prison Rape Elimination Act (PREA). If there is any variation in the laws, the stricter regulation will apply. It is the policy of Keenan House to provide training to all staff and residents to prevent sexual misconduct. Keenan House will fully investigate and prosecute any staff, resident, contractor, volunteer, intern, or visitor involved in such conduct. Keenan House has designated John E. Dillensnyder III, Executive Director, as the current acting PREA Compliance Officer to ensure compliance with all standards across all agency programs and facilities.

Keenan House has a system in place to collect data on incidents of a sexual nature. There were 2 reported allegations for the period August 2019 through August 2020. The following table illustrates that data:
