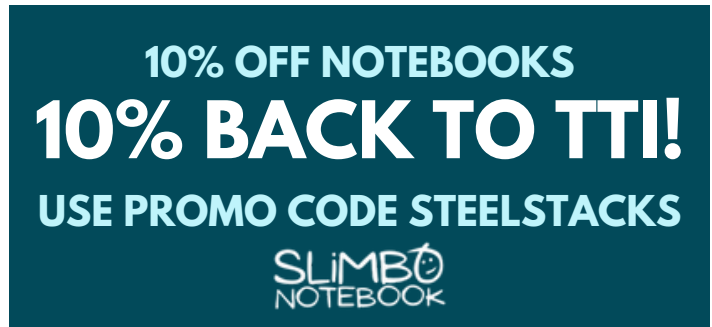

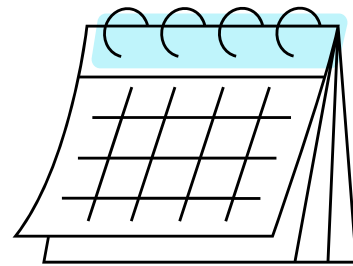
Lehigh Mission District - Thank You!
